(b) To discuss the admission related matters pertaining to acceptability of the degrees offered by EIILM University (Sikkim).

## Resolutions

The Executive Council of Vidyasagar University noted the advise submitted by the Committee constituted by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor regarding the acceptability of the degrees offered by EIILM University (Sikkim). The Executive Council also noted the instructions made by the UGC pertaining to non-acceptability of the degrees awarded by EIILM University, Sikkim for higher education purpose because in most of the cases the degrees are manufactured without taking any examination as reported by the said committee in their advise. The Executive Council noted further that the Committee recommends not to accept such degrees in case of admission in the Vidyasagar University.

After thorough discussion on the advise submitted by the Committee regarding the acceptability of the degrees offered by EIILM it was resolved unanimously that the advise submitted by the Committee 'not to accept the degrees offered by EIILM' be accepted except Bio-Technology for higher education. Resolved also that before admitting any candidate from the areas of Bio-Technology (who have completed education from EIILM) the University authority will check thoroughly that the said course was attended by the concerned candidate in the said University campus. Resolved further that the Registrar be requested to issue a notification to all academic and other concerned departments in this regard. Resolved again that the admissions made by the University authority in different courses from the EIILM University be cancelled except the Bio-Technology done from its own campus.
