Resolved further that the Registrar of this University be requested to process further regarding this.

Resolution

The Court noted further that the Ninth Executive Council of Vidyasagar University in its Fifteenth (15th) meeting held on 09.09.2022 after thorough discussion on the matter regarding conferment of Endowment Award, namely, "Professor Sudhir Ranjan Das Smriti Puraskar" of Vidyasagar University for the year 2022 accepted the name of the recipient who has been nominated for the award of "Professor Sudhir Ranjan Das Smriti Puraskar - 2022", namely Dr. Subha Majumder based on the recommendation of the Search Committee constituted for this purpose and forwarded the same to the Court for approval.
