Resolution

Resolved that the draft resolutions of the Fifth Meeting of the Seventh Executive Council held on 26.07.2012 be read and confirmed.

Agenda No. - 02

To place before the Executive Council the Report of the Fact Finding Committee constituted by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor to enquire into the allegations and counter-allegations labelled by the teachers of the Department of Anthropology, Vidyasagar University, against one another

Resolution

Consideration of the item was deferred.

Agenda No. - 03

To place before the Executive Council the letter No. DAPL/29563/SB-4/159 dated 13.07.2012 received from M/s. Development Architects Private Limited in connection with Consultancy Services for upgradation of Vidyasagar University Campus.

Resolution

The Executive Council of Vidyasagar University noted the letter No. DAPL/29563/SB-4/159 dated 13.07.2012 received from M/s. Development Architects Private Limited stating that based on the discussion in the chamber of the Vice-Chancellor they have sent the Proforma Invoice along with the letter seeking formal approval of the University authority. On getting the approval they will issue an actual Invoice for payment. As per the Letter of Intent and subsequent letters 15% of their total consultancy fees becomes payable to them on submission of Preliminary Concept Drawings and Preliminary Cost Estimates. They have already submitted the Preliminary Concept Drawings and

Preliminary Cost Estimates for four buildings like, Administrative Building, Canteen Building, Staff Quarter and Distance Education Centre. Now they have put forward their Invoice for first three buildings. In this connection they have requested to take appropriate steps for payment.

After thorough discussion on the letter of M/s. D.A.P.L. relating to consultancy services for approach of Vidyasagar University campus it was resolved that the Invoice for three buildings amounting to Rs.9.00 Lacs submitted by M/s. DAPL for payment be approved. Resolved also that the payment should be made in two installments Rs.5.00 lacs and Rs.4.00 lacs respectively after reporting the same to the Finance Committee of the University.

To consider the recommendations of the Standing Committees for appointment to the posts of (a) Assistant Controller of Examinations, (b) Deputy Inspector of Colleges and (c) Accounts Officer of Vidyasagar University.

Resolution

In case of recommendations of the Standing Committees for appointment to the posts of (a) Assistant Controller of Examinations and (b) the Deputy Inspector of Colleges of Vidyasagar University the matter was deferred.

(C.B) Dte. in connection with allotment of fund to the tune of Rs.5,50,000/- pertaining to external repairing and painting of Block-B (Residential Quarter) at the campus of Vidyasagar University, Midnapore.

Resolution

The Executive Council of Vidyasagar University noted that the matter pertaining to external repairing and painting of Block-B (Residential Quarter) at the campus of Vidyasagar University, Midnapore was placed before the Executive Council in its meeting dated 29.06.2012. The Executive Council also noted that as per the direction of the EC the P.W.(C.B.)Dte has placed the letter bearing No. 387/117WPt.III dated 25.07.2012 requesting for allotment of fund to the tune of Rs.5,50,000.00 (Rupees five lacs fifty thousand) only for the said works.

After careful consideration of the letter of the Executive Engineer, Vidyasagar University Division, P.W.(C.B)Dte. pertaining to allotment of fund to the tune of Rs.5,50,000/- for external repairing and painting of Block-B (Residential Quarter) at the Campus of Vidyasagar University it was resolved that the proposal may be sent to the Government for allotment of fund. Resolved further that the matter be referred to the Finance Committee for discussion.

The Executive Council of Vidyasagar University noted the Note dated 30.07.2012 prepared and submitted by the Office of the Registrar stating that the number of academic departments as well as the number of teachers and students in this University are increasing day by day and accordingly the work load of the Office of the Registrar is also growing up. But the number of non-teaching staff is decreasing (by way of retirement) instead of increasing with work load. In connection with the above at least 05 Junior Assistants in non-teaching cadre may be appointed purely on contract basis in order to cope up with work load of the office of the Registrar.

After careful consideration of the Note prepared and submitted by the Office of the Registrar it was resolved that two Junior Assistants in non-teaching cadre purely on contract basis be sanctioned for the office of the Registrar, Vidyasagar University in order to cope up the work load. Resolved also that after assessing the work load of all the departments (both academic and non-academic) a proposal be sent to the West Bengal Government for sanctioning additional non-teaching posts.

To consider the letter dated 11.07.2012 submitted by Sri Nayan Ranjan Mahapatra, Senior Assistant-cum-Typist, Office of the Registrar, Vidyasagar University in connection with changing the date of effect of promotion to the post of Senior Assistant-cum-Typist from 07.11.2006 in place of 02.10.2008.

To discuss the matter relating to incorporation of the transactions of the DDE into the Annual Accounts of the University modifying the Regulation No. 5.0.1 of the University.

Resolution

The Executive Council of Vidyasagar University noted the Note dated 14.08.2012 prepared and submitted by the Finance Officer stating that in reply to the facty of the Transaction Audit for the years 2009-2010 & 2010-2011 against the non-inclusion of the Receipts and Payments Accounts of DDE in this University, the University considers the DDE like an affiliated college. It is a separate entity. The University has no direct access to its financial matters and as such university will not bear any financial liability for DDE. Maintenance of accounts including audit is entirely taken care of by the DDE separately which is not included in the Annual Accounts of the University since inception. A meeting of the Departmental Audit Committee was convened by the Higher Education Department, Government of West Bengal to discuss the Broad-sheet replies to Audit Reports wherein

in the minutes forwarded by the Higher Education Department it is stated that the University will modify its Regulation No. 5.0.1 to incorporate the transactions of the DDE into the Annual Accounts of the University within three months. The Accounts of DDE will come under the purview of audit by the Examiner of Local Accounts and the present practice of auditing by Chartered Accountants Firm may also be continued. In this connection the Finance Officer of Vidyasagar University has also stated that the accounts of the University is ready but the same of DDE is under process.

After careful consideration of the Note of the Finance Officer regarding incorporation of the transactions of the DDE into Annual Accounts of the University modifying the Regulation No. 5.0.1 of the University it was resolved that the present practice in this University be continued. Resolved also that the separate accounts of DDE be reflected in the University Accounts. Resolved further that the DDE account be audited by the Local Audit Department, Government of West Bengal.

Agenda No. - 11

To place before the Executive Council the re-employment case of Prof. Bikash Ranjan Pati, Professor, Department of Microbiology who is due to retire from his service on 30.11.2012.

Resolution

The Executive Council of Vidyasagar University considered the application dated 06.08.2012 of Dr. Bikash Ranjan Pati, Professor, Deptt. of Microbiology seeking re-employment beyond the age of 60 years on and from 1st December, 2012.

Resolved also that the nomination of two subject experts in the Screening Committee for re-employment of Prof. Bikash Ranjan Pati by the Executive Council be left to the Vice-Chancellor for necessary action. Resolved further that the Registrar be requested to take necessary steps in this connection.

Resolved also that the nomination of two subject experts in the Screening Committee for extension of re-employment of the incumbent by the Executive Council be left to the Vice-Chancellor for necessary action. Resolved further that the Registrar be requested to take necessary steps in this connection.

To consider the letter dated 03.08.2012 submitted by B.Ed. Sangram Committee, Vidyasagar University, Midnapore in connection with withdrawal of the enhanced fee for B.Ed. Course for the session 2012-2013.

Resolution

The Executive Council of Vidyasagar University noted the letter dated 03.08.2012 submitted by the B.Ed. Sangram Committee, Vidyasagar University, Midnapore stating that at the time of admission to B.Ed. course for the session 2012-2013 the fees-structure was Rs,35,000/-. Now the University authority has enhanced the said fees to Rs.43,000/- for the B.Ed. course from this session. The Executive Council also noted the statement mentioned in the letter that maximum students who have already got admitted in that course belongs to lower income group and they deposited the fees of Rs.35,000/- inspite of their very much economic hardship and it would be impossible for them

to deposit the balance amount at this juncture of time. In this connection they have requested the University to re-consider their appeal and to withdraw the enhanced fees of the B.E.d. course from the session 2012-2013.

After thorough discussion on the letter of the B.Ed. Sangram Committee, Vidyasagar University in connection with withdrawal of the enhanced fee for B.Ed. Course for the session 2012-2013 it was resolved that the matter be regretted.

After thorough discussion on the letter of the Sub-Divisional Officer, Egra Sub-Division and careful consideration of the prayer of A.I.D.S.O., Bazkul Unit regarding increasing of fees in the Education Year 2012-2013 in Bajkul Milani Mahavidyalaya it was resolved that the Inspector of Colleges, Vidyasagar University be requested to make a report after proper enquiry into the matter for further consideration.

To consider the letter dated 17.08.2012 submitted by the State President, West Bengal Trinamul Chhatra Parishad in connection with increasing the intake capacity of different subjects in the colleges situated at Jangalmahal in the district of Paschim Medinipur for the session 2012-2013.

Resolution

The Executive Council of Vidyasagar University noted the letter dated 17.08.2012 submitted by the State President, West Bengal Trinamul Chhatra Parishad stating that many students in the Jangal Mahal could not get admitted themselves in the colleges due to limited seats. In this connection he has requested to increase the intake capacity of different subjects in the colleges situated at Jangal Mahal in the district of Paschim Medinipur so that they can get admit from the session 2012-2013. After thorough discussion on the letter of the State President, West Bengal Trinamul Chhatra Parishad in connection with increasing the intake capacity of different subjects in the colleges situated at Jangalmahal in the district of Paschim Medinipur for the session 2012-2013 it was resolved that the Inspector of Colleges of Vidyasagar University be authorized to survey the admission positions of the colleges and to submit a report in this connection for further consideration.

To report that the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor has been pleased to admit the following candidates to the degree of Doctor of Philosophy in the next Convocation of the University:

Resolution

The Executive Council of Vidyasagar University noted the Note dated 23.08.2012 submitted jointly by Registrar and the Finance Officer stating that The West Bengal State Council of Higher Education in its meeting dated 07.08.2012 discussed that all daily wage employees in the Universities who are working for years in a regular manner should be converted to monthly wage i.e. contractual employees. Therefore this University should also convert the daily wage casual employees to contractual monthly wage ones. In this connection a list of the daily wage employees and their proposed remuneration has been prepared. The Executive Council noted the list of the daily wage employees and their proposed remuneration prepared in this connection.

After thorough discussion on the matter relating to conversion of daily wage casual employees to contractual monthly wage employees engaged in this University and careful consideration of the list prepared in this connection resolved that the daily wage casual employees be converted to contractual monthly wage employees in this University. Resolved also that the list of the employees along with their remuneration prepared in this connection be approved.

To discuss the matter relating to formation of U.G. Board of Studies in different subjects.

Resolution

After thorough discussion on the matter relating to formation of U.G. Board of Studies in different subjects it was resolved that the U.G. Board of Studies in different subjects be formed as per Statute of Vidyasagar University First Statutes 1985 (amended upto 1997).

To consider the Inspection Reports submitted by the duly constituted Inspection Team in connection with extending affiliation to (a) Bengal Teachers' Training College, Chandrakona and (b) Institute of Academic Excellence, Narayangarh in the district of Paschim Medinipur for enhancement of intake capacity of the B.Ed. Course and conducting the B.Ed. Course from the academic session 2012-2013 respectively.

Resolution

The Executive Council considered the Inspection Reports submitted by the duly constituted Inspection Team in connection with extending affiliation to (a) Bengal Teachers' Training College, Chandrakona and (b) Institute of Academic Excellence, Narayangarh in the district of Paschim Medinipur for enhancement of intake capacity of B.Ed. course and conducting the B.Ed. Course from the academic session 2012-2013.

Resolved that the Bengal Teachers' Training College be granted additional intake of 100 students in the B.Ed. course from the academic session 2012-2013 subject to the fulfillment of the following terms & conditions:

- 01. Students will be admitted purely on merit basis and the admission be made by the University centrally through counselling.
- 02. Appointment of Principal and teachers will be made as per the N.C.T.E. norms.
- 03. The Institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- 04. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
- 05. The college must abide by the other requirements as may be prescribed by the University time to time.
- 06. The college must abide by the Vidyasagar University Act, Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations etc. as amended from time to time.
- 07. The Institution shall maintain & update its website as per provisions of NCTE.
- 08. The affiliation of the University shall remain valid so long as the college enjoys the recognition of the N.C.T.E.
- 09. Original copy of the permission letter of N.C.T.E. must be produced to the University within fifteen days from the date of receipt of this letter.
- 10. The college will have to submit a compliance report to the University after fulfilling the above conditions on receipt of which formal approval of additional intake will be granted.

Resolved also that the affiliation be extended to Institute of Academic Excellence for conducting B.Ed. Course from the academic session 2012-2013 subject to the fulfillment of the following terms and conditions:

- 01. The intake capacity at the initial stage for the above mentioned course is 100.
- 02. Students will be admitted purely on merit basis and the admission be made by the University centrally through counselling.
- 03. The College must have to maintain 200 (two hundred) working days in each academic session.
- 04. At least 1 (one) whole-time qualified teacher in each subject of Physical Education, English and Life Science are to be appointed immediately on receipt of the affiliation letter. Joining letters to be submitted to the University within 15 days alongwith a declaration that they are not engaged in any other institution.
- 05. Part-time teachers as and when required may also be appointed.
- 06. The full-time Principal of the College must be appointed as per norms of NCTE.

- 07. The college must abide by the Vidyasagar University Act, Statutes, Ordinances, Regulations etc. as amended from time to time.
- 08. The college must abide by the norms of the N.C.T.E. in this connection.
- 09. The college must build up a Reserved Fund of Rs.20,00,000/- (Rupees twenty lakhs) only within one year.
- 10. Books (both for english and Bengali version) in adequate number for different subjects as per syllabus are to be procured by the college.
- 11. Subscription of Journal (at least Five Journals) are necessary.
- 12. The following method subjects have been granted to Institute of Academic Excellence for the session 2012-2013:
 - (a) Bengali, (b) English, (c) History, (d) Mathematics, (e) Physical Science, (f) Life Science, (g) Geography, (h) Fine Arts and (i) Physical Education.
- 13. Play Ground and facilities for outdoor and indoor games to be developed at the earliest.
- 14. Facilities for cultural activities to be created and maintained by the college.
- 15. Rs.1,500/= (Rupees one thousand five hundred only) per student per annum to be deposited by the college to the affiliating University.
- 16. More Laboratory equipments are to be purchased. Adequate number of Computers and other Lab. equipments are to be purchased.
- 17. Separate class rooms for method subjects are to be provided.
- 18. Common Room will have to be provided for the students.
- 19. The affiliation of the University shall remain valid so long as the college enjoys the recognition of the N.C.T.E.
- 20. Original copy of the recognition letter of N.C.T.E. and the No Objection Certificate of the State Government must be produced to the University within fifteen days from the date of receipt of this letter.
- 21. The college will have to submit a compliance report to the University after fulfilling the above conditions on receipt of which formal affiliation will be extended.
